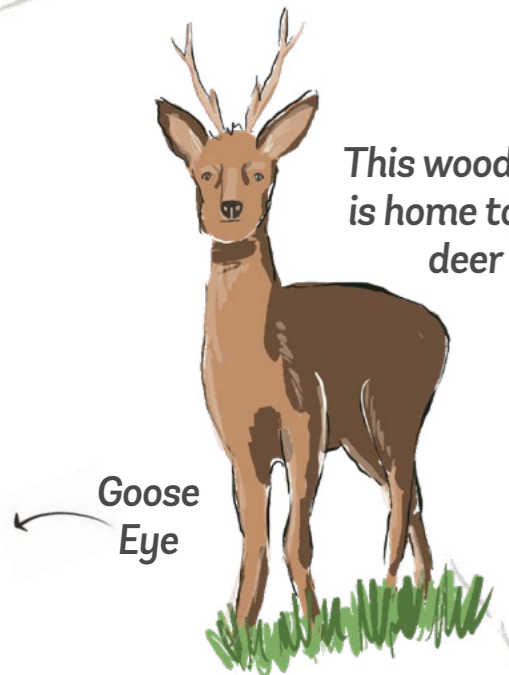


# Captain Tom's Memorial Woodland

Goose Eye

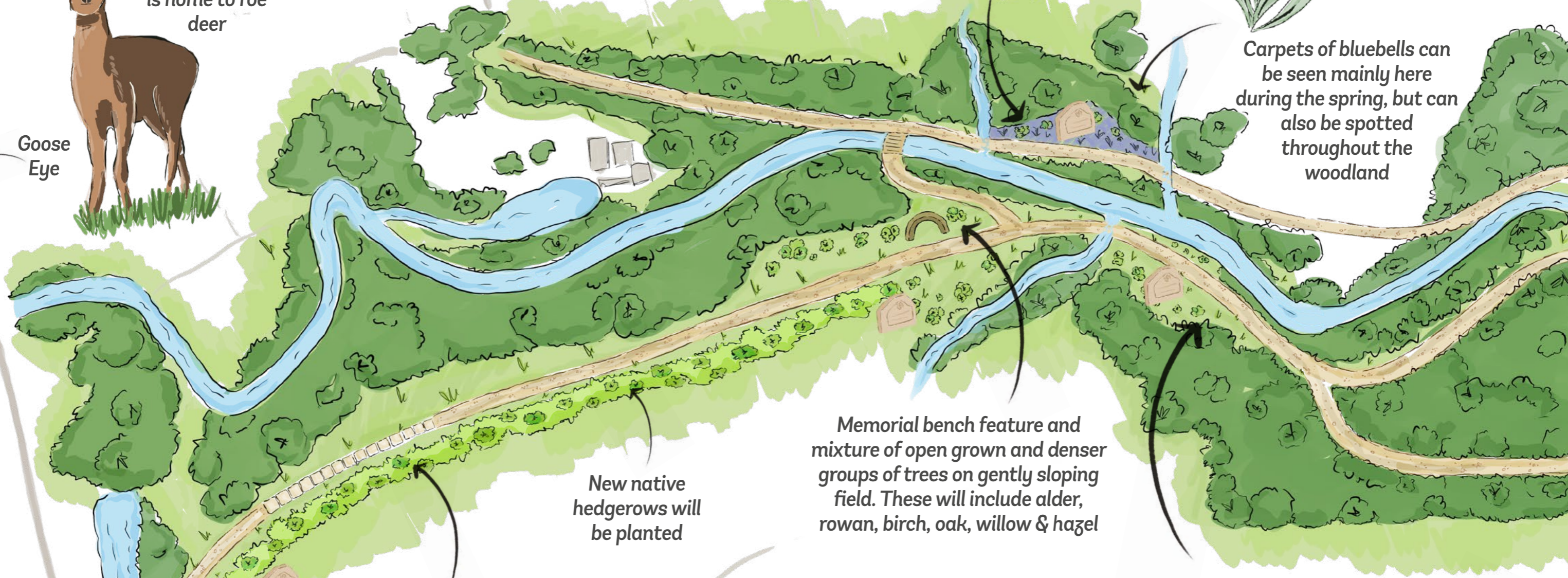
Laycock

Carpets of bluebells can be seen mainly here during the spring, but can also be spotted throughout the woodland

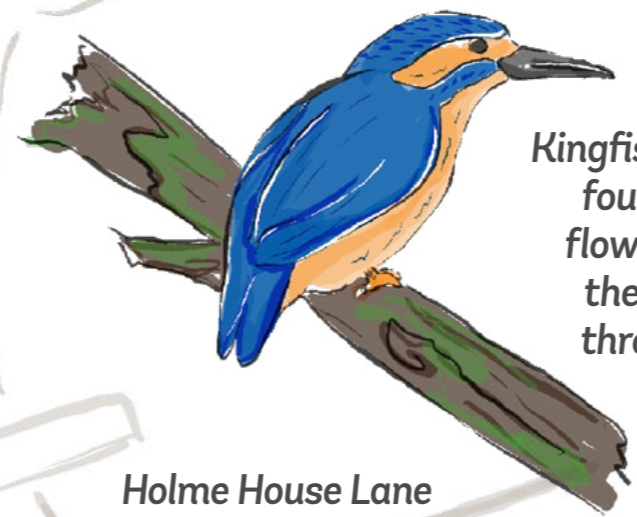


Memorial bench feature and mixture of open grown and denser groups of trees on gently sloping field. These will include alder, rowan, birch, oak, willow & hazel
