Frodsham Wood

Expansive views over the Mersey Estuary and beyond

Frodsham woods were planted on the former golf course over the winter of 2023/4. All of the 30,000 trees were planted by volunteers, local school children, members of the community and our corporate partners. Some of the land has been left for natural regeneration and open meadow areas.

The native tree species will link and buffer the existing woodland at Woodhouse Hill, Frodsham Hill Woods and Sindley Moor, a boost for wildlife, woodland and the local community.

Follow the grassy paths around the wood which can be muddy after prolonged rain. Please respect others and keep your dogs under close control or on a lead.

Close to the wood is the Sandstone Trail which links Frodsham in Cheshire to Whitchurch in North Shropshire, the 55km trail is a popular walking route between the two counties, enjoying spectacular views over the Mersey Estuary and the Welsh Hills.
